- to plan, organize, implement and evaluate the process of their own artistic and artistic-pedagogical activity and education,
- to use the principles of entrepreneurship, to manage their artistic and pedagogical activities,
- to address artistic, theoretical and pedagogical issues in the field of musical composition,
- to design, manage and implement projects within the professional sphere,
- to evaluate information and its source, to process it creatively and use it in practice,

- to apply social protocol and etiquette,
- to communicate and maintain professional communication in a foreign language,
- to learn and expand knowledge in their field, both formally and informally,
- to apply the principles of occupational health and safety, occupational hygiene, fire protection and environmental protection.

6. Officially recognised ways of acquiring the certificate

Successful completion of the continuing six-year training program at the music and drama conservatory (it is possible to enter the university after passing the school leaving examination in the 4th year or after the 5th and 6th year, but not to enter the practice) or 8 years of continuous study at the dance conservatory.

7. Additional information

After successful completion of the training program in the given field of study the graduates receive a certificate confirming their passing of the school leaving examination.

Entry requirements ¹

- Completion of 9th year of primary school
- Completion of lower secondary education, ISCED 244
- Demonstrable talent and fulfilment of prerequisites in the admission procedure or transfer examination from another conservatory
- Talented elementary school student that passed the admission examination (extraordinary study at the conservatory)
- Completed secondary vocational education with the school leaving examination, ISCED 454 (prerequisite for entering the 5th and 6th year)
- Passing the admission examination and demonstrable talent regardless of the applicant's age
- On the basis of differential examinations upon transfer from another conservatory
- Health condition without health, physical and mental disabilities.
