- to apply methods of handling difficult life situations, occupational hazards and mental hygiene principles,
- to think independently and solve conflicts actively,
- to exercise human rights, basic professional legal standards and ethical principles.

Graduates find work in professions and job titles in the field of education of children and students with special educational needs.

Examples of potential job titles include: Educator at schools and educational institutions for children and students with special educational needs.
