- to prepare financial, material and staffing arrangement of various leisure activity programs,
- to apply arts, music and sport to leisure time activities,
- to exercise and protect human rights.

Graduates find work in professions and job titles in the field of education outside school hours, in leisure activity, in educational, cultural institutions and tourist accommodation establishments.

Examples of potential job titles include educator in a leisure time centre, leisure activity leader.
