
### **Notifications**


### What:


Users will be able to receive notifications via e-mail. The notifications feature could be linked to several and in-app (on the platform) for all shared Europass tools (Application Manager, Europass links, application deadlines, newly received Digitally Signed Credentials (DSC). They will also have the support to the user. This is a well-known feature possibility to opt out for what notifications they want to commonly used on many platforms. receive (only for shared links or only via email, etc). They will also be able to see an overview of their notifications on a dedicated Notifications Page. Finally – Notifications are actionable – users will be able to act on notifications (both via email and in-app) - modify (e.g., extend a deadline), delete or simply view the notification.



## **Search Interface**


### What:


Following the implementation of the ELMv3 data model, there is an opportunity to improve the Courses search interface and realise some efficiency in terms of development. Users will be able to make a search for both Courses and Qualifications with additional filters (e.g., Awarding body, teaching language, mode of learning).

Users will be presented with a better view of the course, qualification page.

### Why:

The aim is to improve the search functionality of courses as well as the learning opportunities and qualifications pages; improve the way end-users perform a search, by providing better search norrowing options.


### 1) DEMAND FOR OCCUPATION GROUPS
